The County Championships at Maesdu in Spring had to be cancelled. The August Greensomes at Henllys was also cancelled, but due to all the hard work by Pam, our Lady Secretary there was a 4BBB comp held at Maesdu on 17th August which was very successful. I will let Pam tell you all about that as she was the one who organised it and worked so hard for it to take place. The Autumn Meeting at Pwllheli was cancelled and the 100+ competition also did not take place.

With regard to the All Wales Inter County competition, all the matches had to be cancelled so we had no final at Conwy which was such a shame.

On the 13th of October we, Pam and myself, had a zoom meeting with other Counties: Denbigh & Flint, Mid-Wales and C&A in North Wales and Glamorgan, Monmouth & Carmarthen & Pembroke in South Wales. We discussed the way we were going to play the matches under Covid restrictions safely in 2021 and to try to conduct them so that they could be played in a shorter time, so that way they could be played in one day with no need for an overnight stay.

It was decided that the best way to do this was to play 7 single matches, each match played to a finish, no halved matches, so there would be a final result. We put other things in place to decide a winner of the North and a winner of the South if all the counties in each area tied their matches. We will have to wait and see what restrictions are in place before the final can be played and what venue it will be at. Conwy is still booked in case things improve by then.
